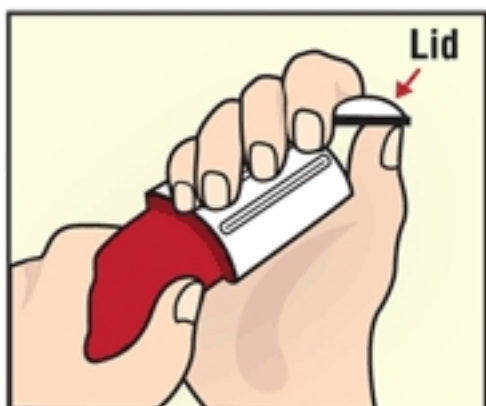


How-to-Use Chimfex®

Chimfex® is easy to activate and easy to use! Simply follow the instructions below.

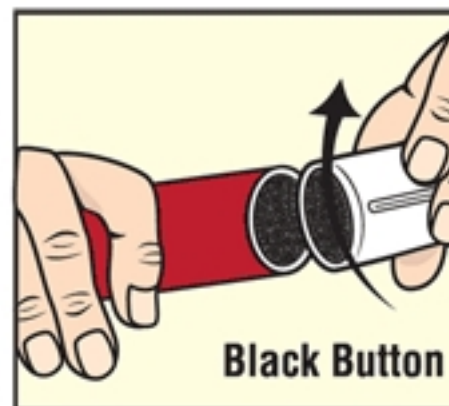
How to Activate



1. Remove top lid to expose scratch surface on the cap.



2. Twist and remove the cap to expose black button.



3. Hold away from face while activating Chimfex® by lightly scratching black button with the cap.



4. Immediately drop *alongside* the fire (*not directly in the fire*).



5. **For fireplaces:** Close door or cover the opening with a non-flammable material.



6. **For wood burning heaters:** Close door and all intake vents.

Note: Chimney fires can re-ignite. Larger flue systems may require more than one Chimfex® stick. We recommend keeping an additional Chimfex® on hand.

Directions for Use

- Before activating, stand in front of fireplace or wood-burning heater.
- Hold Chimfex® at the base so it extends over the fireplace hearth or fireproof stove board.
- To activate, remove top lid to expose the scratch surface on the cap. Twist and remove cap to expose the black button on Chimfex®.
- While holding Chimfex® away from your face and body, lightly scratch the black button with the surface of the cap.

For Fireplaces:

- Activate Chimfex® directly in front of fireplace according to the directions above.
- Drop Chimfex® IMMEDIATELY inside the fireplace ***along side*** the fire
(not directly in the fire)

- Reduce draft as much as possible by closing fireplace doors or covering the fireplace opening with a non-flammable material, leaving the flue damper open.
- The natural draft will draw the fumes up the flue and extinguishes* the chimney fire.

For Wood-Burning Heaters:

- Activate Chimfex® directly in front of heater according to the directions above.
- Drop Chimfex® IMMEDIATELY into stove ***alongside*** the fire (*not directly in the fire*)
- Close air inlet controls, leaving the flue damper open.
- The natural draft will draw the generated fumes up the flue and extinguish the chimney fire.
